

What is the Brief Advice Clinic?

The Oregon Law Center's Columbia County Pro Bono Program pairs private volunteer attorneys with Columbia County residents to provide brief advice and document assistance on a variety of legal issues including family, consumer, small estate, and expungements.

How do attorneys work with the Brief Advice Clinic?

Pro Bono attorneys are sign-up to be contacted for specific types of cases and appointment times based on their personal availability and expertise. The program coordinator will contact them to check conflicts, set-up meeting space if necessary and provide background information and documents.
