What is the Expungement Clinic?

Oregon Law Center's Expungement Clinic pairs low-income clients with volunteer attorneys at a once a month clinic allowing eligible clients to apply for expungement, erasing barriers to employment and housing.

How do attorneys work with the Expungement <u>Clinic?</u>

Attorneys sign-up to volunteer for an afternoon clinic (held monthly in Hillsboro) and receive onsite training and CLE credit. Following the training attorneys meet with clients for one-on-one appointments to advise clients of their eligibility for expungements, and if eligible, to fill out applicable paperwork to be filed pro se with the court.
